ACTIVITY: "Investigate **THE RUINS AT STONEHENGE** and **MENHIRS OF CARNAC** on the Internet"

Aims: Analyze the structures of stone circles and menhirs

Time: 1 hour

**Interaction:** groups

**Skills:** listening, speaking, writing, reading

**Preparation**: computers/tablets; create a power point presentation

**PROCEDURE**: Divide the class into two groups. Surf the net and look for information about the ruins at Stonehenge or the menhirs of Carnac. Find the answers to the following questions about the you choose. Take notes and remember the ideas you find. You will need this information later:

**LOCATION:** where is it? Why do you think the builders chose that specific place to build it?

**APPEARANCE AND LOGISTIC**: Why do you think the builders chose that specific place to build it? Investigate its environment, where it was built and its and the surroundings. Describe it.

**PURPOSE**: What do you think it was built for? Who do you think used it? How often do you think they used it?

**VISIT**: If you wanted to go there, how would you do it? What means of transport would you take? Is it close to any village, or isolated? Would you need any special means of transport to get there, like a 4X4? What activities will you do while there? (Sightseeing, meditation, rain dance, hide and seek, etc...). Communicate the plan in a presentation to another group or to the class.

**GATHER INFORMATION**: Collect photos, articles, videos, images, etc. of the topic you choose and classify the information. (Classify the information example: "Interior", "Surroundings", "Transport", "Materials", etc...)

**FINAL ACTIVITY:** Communicate the plan in a presentation to another group or to the class.
